From the Desk of Fr. Andy

Dear St. Paul Family,

This weekend is the kick-off weekend for the 2012 Bishop's Appeal. You were most generous last year in helping to reach our Bishop's Appeal goal of \$58,397. This year our parish goal set by the diocese is \$59,376. Let's all work really hard together to make our Bishop's Appeal goal for a third year in a row. This money is used by the many diocesan departments for the work of evangelization and social services through Catholic Charities throughout our Diocese. Some of the ministries the Bishop's Appeal supports are Catholic Charities, the diocesan Education Department, the Compass and the Lay Ministry Formation program, to name a few. Has the Bishop's Appeal ever been used to pay legal settlements?

No, the Bishop's Appeal has never been used to pay legal settlements. In fact, between 1950 and 2004 the Diocese paid approximately \$1,365,000 in legal settlements. From this settlement \$1,065,000 came from liability insurance and the other \$300,000 came from diocesan investments. Gifts to the Bishop's Appeal have always been used to share the ministries and services of the Diocese of Green Bay with our parishes, Catholic schools, and communities throughout northeastern Wisconsin.

Scripture Reflection

Job in the first reading speaks of life as a drudgery, where he is a slave and his life is full of misery. And yet Job still trusted in God. In the second reading, Paul says he has made himself a slave to all, for the sake of the Gospel. And Jesus in the Gospel of Mark heals the sick and then goes off to pray. But he is pursued by his Apostles, saying, "Everyone is looking for you." Jesus responds, "For this purpose I have come." In a very real way, Jesus was enslaved by his ministry. He was hounded by and surrounded by people who wanted to hear him preach, but who also wanted him to heal them. We have grown up in a society where slavery is considered evil. And the kind of slavery where some people hurt other people is evil. But our relationship to our God should be a voluntary slavery, where we freely give up our control to our God. In heaven only God can be in control, and if we want to get there we have to make God our master. For this reason God sends challenges into our lives, like he did for Job. He does this so that we might turn to God, in both good times and in bad, and declare to Him that we love Him and trust Him anyway.
