

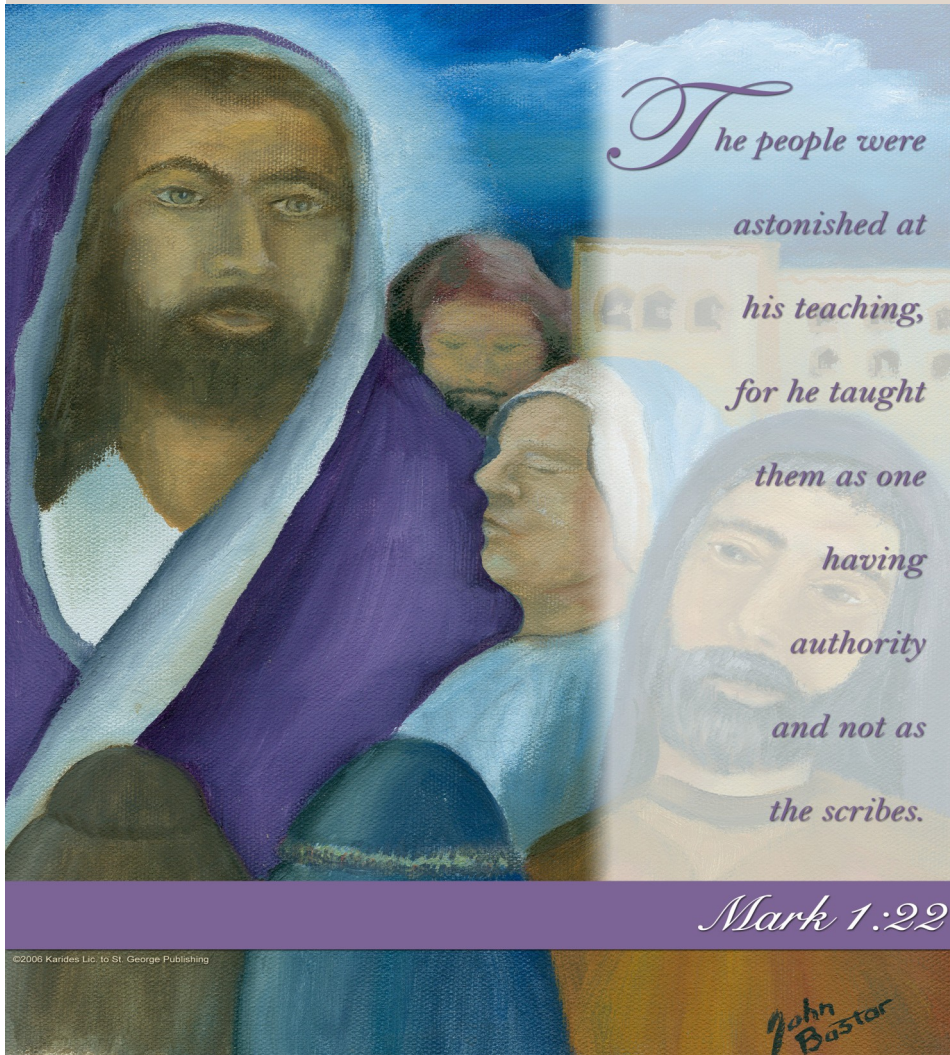

From the Desk of Fr. Andy

Dear St. Paul Family,

I would just like to remind everyone that we now have a shrine to St. Peregrine which is located in the side chapel to the left of the Sanctuary. St. Peregrine is the patron saint of those afflicted with Cancer. I am sure just about everyone either knows someone with cancer or perhaps have been afflicted with cancer themselves. In the chapel next to the statue of St. Peregrine are blessed metals and holy cards for your use. Please help yourself to these blessed items to pray for yourself or someone you may know that is afflicted with cancer. There is now also a vigil light stand next to the statue if you care to light a candle for a specific intention. You may pray in the chapel on weekends either before or after Mass, or during the week by coming in the west side parking lot entrance during daytime office hours.

This past Christmas we distributed 500 CDs entitled *The Seven Pillars of Catholic Spirituality*. A few people have commented to me how much they appreciated listening to the CD. If you have listened to it I would appreciate any feedback you may want to share with me. If you want to e-mail me with any thoughts my e-mail address is on the front cover of the bulletin. If you have not had an opportunity to listen to it yet, please do so. You will not be disappointed. Feel free to pass on your CDs to someone else after you have listened to it.

Some concerns have been brought forward about our set up for the Sacrament of Reconciliation. We are working on a plan for building a new permanent confessional. It is my hope that this project will be able to begin sometime yet this winter. I will keep you posted as more details come available.

I would also like to encourage everyone to continue wearing your nametags to Mass each week. It has been a while since I have made this reminder, but please continue to wear them. It is a great way for us to get to know each other by name.

Scripture Reflection

The reference to Meribah in the desert speaks about being willing to trust in the Word of God. The Israelites had just been rescued from Egypt by Moses through the plagues and crossing the Red Sea. And yet at Meribah they complained about God to Moses because they were thirsty. God told Moses to strike a rock so water would flow from it for the people. Moses did strike the rock and water flowed out, but Moses hit the rock twice rather than striking it once and simply trusting in God. Because of this lack of trust, Moses was not allowed to cross over the Jordan into the Promised Land. This seems like an unreasonable punishment for such a little flaw, but Moses knew better than to doubt. Moses put the worries of the people before his trust in God. In the gospel, when Jesus speaks with “authority”, it means he teaches on his own, rather than consulting with other rabbis as was the custom. Jesus not only taught an amazingly profound message, but he also worked many miracles, even raising three people from the dead. And yet, just like the Israelites in the desert, the Jewish people eventually turned against Jesus and crucified him, because Jesus claimed to be the Son of God. The moral of the story is that Jesus has more than proven he is the Son of God, and we should be willing to trust him and be obedient to him. No grumbling about suffering or complaining about Jesus’ teachings if we want to get to the Promised Land.
